Waterfront Contractors Introduced K and E Excavation was introduced as the Construction Manager General Contractor on the Water Avenue project

at the November 16 CARA meeting. They have the capability to perform roughly 60% of the project and will use subs for the remainder. While based in Salem, many of their team members live in Albany and Millersburg.

Splashpad Grant Accepted

The Albany Revitalization Agency was awarded a grant for \$75,000 to build a playground and splash pad in the new Monteith Park.

Wells Fargo Demolition Awarded

A contract for the demolition of the former Wells Fargo Building was awarded at the November 28 ARA meeting.

"There were three bids received and the lowest responsible, responsive bidder was Willamette Construction Services dba Laneco Demolition in the amount of \$238,686," said Sophie Adams, Economic Development Coordinator.

There are items of special interest and historical significance that staff has been working to preserve. One item of particular interest is a time capsule, said to have been placed in the cornerstone of the building in 1912, that is hoped to be recovered.


