CARA Update

The Wells Fargo Bank Building will be demolished starting mid-February and is estimated to be finished by the end of April. The demolition experts. Laneco Inc., have until June 30 to finish if they run into any delays.

The timing was set to avoid summer events and the heavy visitor season.

Once removed the lot will be graveled and await a new opportunity. An RFP for the future development of the lot is currently being prepared and will be discussed at the February ARA meeting on Wednesday, February 15.



Due to the demolition of the Wells Fargo Bank Building at the corner of 1st & Broadalbin, parking will be unavailable in most of the Bank Lot and on the street adjacent to the building starting later this month. Also, the east section of the alley will be closed for safety.

Asbestos abatement is already underway. Demolition is set to begin on Monday, February 20, and should take about five weeks. Park-Wise leased space and permit holders will be provided alternate parking options. Those businesses that receive deliveries from trucks in the alley should contact their vendors to discuss options.


