Albany Civic Theater presents *Eclipsed* by Patricia Burke Brogan. *Eclipsed* is a powerful and moving award-winning play with dozens of productions around the world.

Set in a Magdalene laundry in the 1960s, the all-woman play documents the Irish Catholic church and their practice of incarcerating pregnant and unwed Irish mothers in church-run laundries making them work as penitents.

If you saw the film *Philomena*, you have seen the story of one Magdalene. Although a drama, the play is filled with mo-

ments of humor as well as song. Note: This show has adult content and subject matter. Directed by: Charlotte J. Headrick.

Performances are March 1, 2, 3(m), 7, 8 and 9. Evening performances start at 7:30 pm. Matinees start at 2:30 pm. Box office opens 45 minutes before curtain.
